ADJOURNMENT:

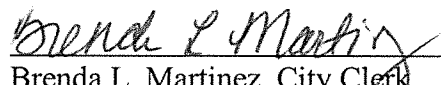
There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned by Mayor Wagner at 8:46 p.m.
