RESOLUTION NO. 23-1533

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF BLACK DIAMOND, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON
SUPPORTING THE ENUMCLAW SCHOOL DISTRICT NO.
216'S PROPOSITION 1 GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS
- \$253,210,000**

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 1126 was adopted by the Board of Directors of Enumclaw School District No. 216 of King County Washington, concerning this proposition for bonds; and

WHEREAS, the Enumclaw School District is one of the four school districts serving the Black Diamond community; and

WHEREAS, this proposition would authorize the District to construct a new elementary school, a performing arts center, and stadium/athletic complex; replace Byron Kibler Elementary and the early learning center at JJ Smith; make safety, security and infrastructure upgrades to District facilities, and upgrade athletic fields and properties; and

WHEREAS, if passed by the voters during the February 14, 2023 Special Election, the \$253,210,000 of general obligation bonds would mature within 21 years, and be repaid from annual excess property tax levies; and

WHEREAS, RCW 42.17A.555 permits the City Council to support or oppose a ballot proposition at an open public meeting so long as notice of the meeting includes the title and number of the ballot proposition and members of the Council and public are afforded an approximately equal opportunity to express an opposing view;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY BLACK DIAMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council proclaims its support for the Enumclaw School District's Proposition 1 General Obligation Bonds - \$253,210,000 and encourages its passage at the February 14, 2023, Special Election.
